



## Jack Stollsteimer – PA Attorney General

Jack's journey is deeply rooted in his family's pursuit of the American Dream, shaped by his father's service in the U.S. Army and his mother's resilience after surviving a Nazi slave labor camp. Inspired by their struggles and triumphs, Jack worked his way through college and law school. His career in law began as an intern with the Delaware County District Attorney's Office, where he later served as an Assistant District Attorney, prosecuting criminals.

In 2001, he joined the U.S. Department of Justice, earning a 100% conviction rate as an Assistant U.S. Attorney, focusing on gun violence reduction. Jack's commitment extended to addressing issues in education, as Governor Rendell appointed him as Pennsylvania's Safe Schools Advocate. His advocacy for reporting violent crimes in the Philadelphia School District led to policy changes, contributing to a Pulitzer Prize-winning series on school violence in 2012.

In 2017, he became Deputy State Treasurer, working on initiatives like the PA ABLE savings program for people with disabilities and the Keystone Scholars grant program, providing educational opportunities for every child born or adopted in Pennsylvania. Jack Stollsteimer was the first Democrat to be elected District Attorney in Delaware County, the place where his parents and now his family have lived since the 1950s.

As Delaware County's district attorney Stollsteimer:

- Formed the Chester Partnership for Safe Neighborhoods. Three years in, it has helped reduce the gun violence homicide rate in the City of Chester by nearly SEVENTY PERCENT.
- Reformed our criminal justice system by working to place our for-profit county jail back under public management and created diversionary programs for low level offenders that have reduced our jail population by 30%.
- Was one of only two DAs in Pennsylvania to publicly pledge to never prosecute a woman for exercising her constitutional right to an abortion.
- Successfully prosecuted contractors in the construction industry for stealing from their workers through misclassification wage theft schemes—the only DA to do so.
- Created the first Environmental Crimes Unit in any DA's office in order to better protect our planet and our people from environmental injustices.
- Decriminalized the possession of marijuana for personal use.
- Successfully sued opioid distributors in a civil action in order to bring home millions of dollars to help those with substance abuse disorders.

Jack's diverse experience, from prosecuting criminals to advocating for safer schools and innovative financial programs, positions him as a candidate for Attorney General with a proven track record of dedication to justice and the well-being of Pennsylvanians.
