- Only sign petitions when the top section is completely filled out
- Sign in ink
- Do not use ditto marks on a petition
- You must be a registered Democrat
- You must live in the municipality or district of the position on the petition. [CLICK HERE](#) to find your municipality and district information in the "Voting Center Links."
- You must provide you street address, not your mailing address
- You must list the municipality you live in for "City, Boro or Twp" block on the petition, not your mailing address. For example, you may have a Coplay mailing address, but your municipality is North Whitehall Township.
- The name you provide on a petition must match the name on your voter registration
- The number of petitions you can sign for a particular position depends on the number of openings. If there are four open spots, you may sign up to four petitions for that position..
